MINUTES OF THE SELECTION
ODESSA NATIONAL ACADEMY OF FOOD TECHNOLOGIES (ONAFI)

ONAFI selection committee for pre-selectioning of candidates for participation in the Erasmus+ programme – International Credit Mobility with University of Padova (Italy) consisted of:

ONAFI selection committee meeting took place on April, 5.

The agenda for the meeting was to assess candidates who are participating in the call and to approve a list of nominated students.

Head of the selection committee professor Marina Mardar gave the general information about the call, specifically:

1. Information about the call for application was published on main website of ONAFI (<https://onaft.edu.ua/news/12>). Also, it was published on website of ONAFI International Collaboration Centre (<http://inter.onaft.edu.ua/konkurs-na-otrimannya-stipendij-na-navchannya-kreditna-akademichna-mobilnist-v-paduanskomu-universiteti-italiya-v-ramkah-programi-erasmus/>).

2. Deadline of application submission was announced on April 2, 2018 12:00.

3. The selection criteria adopted are:

- Academic achievements (40%);
- Knowledge of English (25%);
- Motivation (15%);
- Social activity / involvement in scientific activities (10%).

It was also noted that the first criterion is academic merit. However, with equivalent academic level, preference would be given to candidates from less advantaged socio-economic backgrounds.

It was further stated that ONAFT has 4 scholarships for students. It was decided that these scholarships should be divided between 2 faculties which have the most common to "Italian wine and food" educational programs: Hotel and restaurant business and Food Technology (training programs (majors): Technology of fermentation products and wine).

These are faculties:

1. Faculty of Innovative nutrition technologies and restaurant and hotel business.
2. Faculty of Wine technology and tourism business.

Faculty of Wine technology and tourism business was granted with 1 scholarship. Faculty of Innovative nutrition technologies and restaurant and hotel business was granted with 3 scholarships.

From the former faculty 3 applications were received, from the latter faculty it was 1. So, it was decided that as it was only one candidate from Faculty of Wine technology and tourism business another scholarship should be transferred to Faculty of Innovative nutrition technologies and restaurant and hotel business. In this way,
